To an outstanding green construction project. The project must have more than 50% of its construction be outside existing buildings.

To an outstanding green home or homes project.

To any member who has shown outstanding leadership in the field of green building.

#### **MEMBER FIRM OF THE YEAR**

To any member firm that has shown outstanding leadership in the field of green building.
